Effective January 1, 2021.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

Proposed law will result in a one-time SGR expenditure for the Office of Group Benefits (OGB) that is anticipated to be negligible. The proposed measure is permissive and does not mandate health insurers to carry telehealth/telemedicine coverage, but requires insurers to list certain information regarding telehealth/telemedicine coverage on their respective websites to the extent they offer it. OGB anticipates a marginal one-time cost to update its website to highlight where beneficiaries may find telehealth/telemedicine information at Blue Cross Blue Shield of LA's webpage, as BCBSLA acts as OGB's third-party administrator.

Furthermore, the proposed legislation outlines statutory requirements that providers offering remote patient monitoring services must meet to be eligible for reimbursement from insurers offering that coverage, but does not require coverage for such services.

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
