<u>Prior law</u> authorized every motor vehicle insurer authorized to transact business in this state to provide a 25% premium discount on automobile liability insurance purchased in this state to active military personnel based in the state.

<u>New law</u> provides that except for administering military personnel premium discounts, the fact that an insured is deployed in the military for a period in excess of six months shall not be used by the insurer for the classification of risk.

<u>Prior law</u> authorized every homeowner's insurer authorized to transact business in this state to provide a ten percent premium discount on any homeowner's policy purchased in this state to cover immovable property owned by active military personnel based in the state.

<u>New law</u> provides that except for administering military personnel premium discounts, the fact that an insured is deployed in the military for a period in excess of six months shall not be used by the insurer for the classification of risk.

Effective August 1, 2020.
