**Abstract:** Increases the maximum amount a supplier of mechanical repairs and services may charge as a service fee for the use of shop supplies.

<u>Present law</u> requires suppliers of mechanical repairs and services for any vehicle subject to <u>present law</u> to provide an itemized bill to each consumer.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> allows the supplier to charge a service fee for the use of certain shop supplies that are not itemized, as long as the fee does not exceed a maximum amount.

Proposed law retains present law but increases the maximum amount that can be charged.

<u>Present law</u> requires the service fee to be the lesser of 5% of the total invoice for mechanical repair or \$35.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> to require the service fee be the lesser of 10% of the total invoice for mechanical repair or \$50.
