Fields

<u>Prior law</u> regarding workers' compensation, provided weekly death benefits to a surviving spouse who was actually living with the decedent at the time of injury or death or was dependent on the decedent for support.

<u>Prior law</u> provided that the workers' compensation weekly death benefit payments continue until death or remarriage of the surviving spouse.

<u>New law</u> provides an exception for the surviving spouse of a law enforcement officer, who was killed in the line of duty, to allow workers' compensation weekly death benefits to continue after remarriage.

Effective August 1, 2020.
