Fields

Prior law regarding workers' compensation, provided weekly death benefits to a surviving spouse who was actually living with the decedent at the time of injury or death or was dependent on the decedent for support.

Prior law provided that the workers' compensation weekly death benefit payments continue until death or remarriage of the surviving spouse.

New law provides an exception for the surviving spouse of a law enforcement officer, who was killed in the line of duty, to allow workers' compensation weekly death benefits to continue after remarriage.

Effective August 1, 2020.
