2	To enact R.S. 33:103(C)(1)(o), relative to the Washington Parish planning commission; to
3	authorize the governing authority of the parish to pay members a per diem for
4	attending commission meetings; to provide relative to the amount of the per diem
5	and for the number of meetings for which members may be paid; and to provide for
6	related matters.
7	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
8	as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
9	Louisiana.
10	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
11	Section 1. R.S. $33:103(C)(1)(o)$ is hereby enacted to read as follows:
12	§103. Planning commission; membership; appointment
13	* * *
14	C.(1) All members of a commission, whether a parish or a municipal
15	planning commission, shall serve without compensation, except as otherwise
16	provided by this Paragraph or as otherwise provided by law, and shall hold no other
17	public office, except they may also serve as members of any duly constituted
18	regional commission of which their parish or municipality forms a part.

20	(o) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the
21	governing authority of Washington Parish may pay members of the parish planning
22	commission a per diem of not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than sixty
23	dollars for attendance at meetings of the commission for a maximum of twenty-four

1	meetings per year. Any such per diem shall be paid by the parish governing
2	authority from monies appropriated from the general fund of the parish.
3	* * *
4	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
5	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
6	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
7	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
8	effective on the day following such approval.
