2 To commend and recognize Andy Washington upon the celebration of his one hundredth
3 birthday.

5 from 1942 to 1946; and

7 Michael Paradise, commanding officer of Coast Guard Base New Orleans, at a 100th
8 birthday celebration in New Orleans which included a parade of vehicles organized by
9 friends and family; and

11 learned of the joyous occasion of Andy Washington's one hundredth birthday, and it is only
