<u>New law</u> creates the crime of adulterating a food product and defines the offense as the intentional contamination of a food product by adding to the product, or mingling with the product, any feces, urine, blood, saliva, semen, any form of human or animal waste, or other bodily substance with the intent that the product be provided to or consumed by another person who has no knowledge of nor consents to the contamination.

New law defines "food product".

<u>New law</u> provides that whoever commits the <u>proposed law</u> crime shall be fined not more than \$2,000, imprisoned with or without hard labor for not more than five years, or both.

Effective Aug. 1, 2020.
