<u>Prior law</u> provided that pretrial motions shall be made or filed within 15 days after arraignment, unless a different time is provided by law or fixed by the court at arraignment upon a showing of good cause why 15 days is inadequate.

<u>New law</u> amends <u>prior law</u> to provide that all pretrial motions shall be made within 30 days after the receipt of initial discovery, unless a different time is provided by law or fixed by the court upon a showing of good cause why 30 days in inadequate.
