<u>Existing law</u> authorizes parishes to create waterworks districts, which have control of water systems in their respective districts. Provides for meetings of the board of commissioners of any such district.

<u>Existing law</u> authorizes a per diem for waterworks district commissioners for attendance of meetings. <u>Existing law</u> provides that per diem shall be paid for up to 24 regular meetings and 12 special meetings each year. <u>Prior law</u> provided generally that the maximum per diem was \$60. <u>New law</u> changes the authorized per diem amount to not less than \$60 and not more than per diem paid to members of the La. legislature.

<u>Prior law</u> provided for higher limits on per diem for particular districts and parishes. <u>New</u> law repeals these particular provisions in accordance with new law.

Effective Aug. 1, 2020.
