Abstract: Requires that during a declared state of emergency or public health emergency, restaurants and bars be subject to the same restrictions, if any.

Present law authorizes the governor or a parish president to declare a state of emergency pursuant to the La. Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act.

Present law authorizes the governor to declare a state of public health emergency pursuant to the La. Health Emergency Powers Act.

Proposed law provides that during a state of emergency as declared by the governor or the parish president or during a public health emergency restaurants and bars shall be subject to the same restrictions, if any, including restrictions on occupancy and operation.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
