The petition may establish and confine the applicability of a 14 15 period during which no other declaration of a public health emergency may be issued and 16 shall include a date and time on which the state of public health emergency terminates. The petition shall be submitted to the clerical officer of the respective house. Upon receipt of a 17
- 18 valid petition, the clerical officer shall transmit copies of the signed petition to the other
- 19 house, the governor, and the secretary of state. The clerical officer shall give notice to the
- 20 public of the termination of the state of public health emergency by publishing the petition 21 on the joint legislative website and in the official journal of the state. No additional action
- 22 is required to effectuate the termination of the state of public health emergency."
