5 control have authority to take actions, not inconsistent with law, as deemed necessary
6 to ensure a respective licensee's compliance with the provisions of this Chapter.

7 §3214. Applicability

8 The provisions of this Chapter do not apply to a location of business in the
9 state of Louisiana where a physical copy of an individual's current driver's license,
10 valid passport or visa issued by the federal government or another country or nation,
11 or other card of identity is held in compliance with state or federal law."
