On page 2, delete lines 16 through 20 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:
"(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter to the contrary, a federally insured depository institution shall not be required to accept a digitized identification card as a valid form of identification. However, a federally insured depository institution may, at its option, accept a digitized identification card as a valid form of identification."

On page 3 , after line 5 , add the following:
"\$3213. Powers and duties
The Louisiana Gaming Control Board and the office of alcohol and tobacco control have authority to take actions, not inconsistent with law, as deemed necessary to ensure a respective licensee's compliance with the provisions of this Chapter.
§3214. Applicability
The provisions of this Chapter do not apply to a location of business in the state of Louisiana where a physical copy of an individual's current driver's license, valid passport, or visa issued by the federal government or another country or nation, or other card of identity is held in compliance with state or federal law."
