SCHOOLS. Provides regarding purchase of telecommunications and video equipment by certain educational entities. (1/1/21) (Item #42)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Change reference to federal provision from Section 889 of the Fiscal Year 2019 National Defense Authorization Act to Section 889(a) of the same Act.
2. Specify that the telecommunications and video surveillance equipment subject to proposed law is the equipment described in the federal provision.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

Proposed law prohibits all of the following entities from purchasing telecommunications or video surveillance equipment as described in Section 889(a) of the Fiscal Year 2019 National Defense Authorization Act unless such equipment is from a manufacturer that is in compliance with such federal provision:

- (1) Public elementary, secondary, and postsecondary schools, institutions, and governing authorities.
- (2) Nonpublic elementary, secondary, and postsecondary schools, institutions, and governing authorities that receive state funds.
- (3) Proprietary schools that receive state funds.

Proposed law further requires the vendor of such equipment to provide an affidavit that the equipment is from a manufacturer that is in compliance with such federal provision.

Effective January 1, 2021.
