6 months after it is submitted to the system, but the employer may renew the  
7 certification."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 2, line 23, after "emergency" delete the remainder of the line and insert "for which  
10 he is reemployed."

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 3, delete lines 27 and 28 and insert the following:

13 "to or operations during the emergency. Such a certification shall expire six  
14 months after it is submitted to the system, but the employer may renew the  
15 certification."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 5

17 On page 4, line 2, after "emergency" delete the remainder of the line and insert "for which  
18 he is reemployed."

20 On page 5, line 7, delete "also"
