HEALTH CARE. Requests that teachers, members of law enforcement, and firefighters be given preference for COVID-19 testing.

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To urge and request the health care providers of Louisiana who administer COVID-19 tests
3	to give preference to the testing of teachers, members of law enforcement, and
4	firefighters.
5	WHEREAS, the first presumptive case relating to the COVID-19 pandemic in
6	Louisiana was announced on March 9, 2020, and on March 11, 2020, the governor issued
7	the first proclamation of a public health emergency in Louisiana, Proclamation Number 25
8	JBE 2020; and
9	WHEREAS, the federal Cybersecurity & Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA)
10	publishes the "Guidance on the Essential Critical Infrastructure Workforce: Ensuring
11	Community and National Resilience in COVID-19 Response" to aid public and private
12	employers in determining who is an essential critical infrastructure worker; and
13	WHEREAS, CISA's list of essential critical infrastructure workers includes teachers,
14	members of law enforcement, and firefighters; and
15	WHEREAS, teachers provide vital and necessary services and care to children,
16	families, and communities and are shaping the future of Louisiana; and
17	WHEREAS, law enforcement officers, including state troopers, sheriff's deputies,
18	and municipal police officers provide a vital public service by playing an essential role in

2	WHEREAS, firefighters save lives, stabilize hazardous situations, and conserve
3	property, as well as fill an important role in educating the public by teaching fire prevention
4	and how to respond in emergency situations; and
5	WHEREAS, teachers, members of law enforcement, and firefighters may have
6	regular contact with large numbers of people, frequent interactions with the public, or work
7	in an environment where it is not practical to maintain at least six feet of space from other
8	workers on a consistent basis; and
9	WHEREAS, teachers, members of law enforcement, and firefighters have continued
10	to provide critical services since the start of the pandemic and face increased risk of COVID-
11	19 exposure; and
12	WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide teachers, members of law enforcement, and

safeguarding the rights and freedoms of the state's residents; and
