2	To amend and reenact R.S. 46:2751(C), 2752(C) and (D), 2755(B)(introductory paragraph),
3	and 2756 and to enact R.S. 46:2751(B)(1)(i) and (4), 2752(E), and 2755(B)(5),
4	relative to the Juvenile Justice Reform Act Implementation Commission; to provide
5	relative to the commission's purposes, powers, and duties; to provide relative to the
6	membership of the commission; to require the commission to consider the well-being
7	of youth in the juvenile justice system during a public health emergency; to provide
8	relative to meetings of the commission; to provide relative to officers of the
9	commission; to require annual reports of the commission; to provide for an effective
10	date; and to provide for related matters.
11	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
12	Section 1. R.S. 46:2751(C), 2752(C) and (D), 2755(B)(introductory paragraph), and
13	2756 are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 46:2751(B)(1)(i) and (4), 2752(E), and
14	2755(B)(5) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
15	§2751. Juvenile Justice Reform Act Implementation Commission; creation;
16	composition; duties

18	B.(1) The commission shall be composed as follows:

20	(i) The chairman of the House Committee on Administration of Criminal
21	Justice or his designee.

1	(4) The appointed representative of the Families and Friends of Louisiana's
2	Incarcerated Children shall serve as the vice chairperson of the commission.
3	C. The commission shall have as its purpose the implementation of the
4	recommendations contained in the Juvenile Justice Reform Act of 2003 and HCR
5	House Concurrent Resolution No. 56 or SCR Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 31,
6	or both, of the 2003 Regular Session of the Legislature, and the continued reform of
7	the state's juvenile justice system, the well-being of youth in the juvenile justice
8	system during a public health emergency, and House Concurrent Resolution No. 47
9	of the 2020 Regular Session of the Legislature.
10	§2752. Rules; meetings; officers

12	C. The commission shall meet for the first time no later than August 1, 2003
13	January 15, 2021, and shall meet at such other times as shall be necessary to
14	accomplish its purposes.
15	D. The commission shall meet at least once each quarter.
16	<u>E.</u> The commission shall elect such additional officers as it finds necessary.

20	B. The commission in its consideration of the recommendations of the
21	Juvenile Justice Reform Act of 2003 and HCR House Concurrent Resolution No. 56
22	or SCR Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 31, or both, of the 2003 Regular Session
23	of the Legislature, and in the consideration of recommendation of other juvenile
24	justice reform measures shall address such issues as:

26	(5) The well-being of youth in the juvenile justice system during a public
27	health emergency and House Concurrent Resolution No. 47 of the 2020 Regular

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1	§2756. Reports; recommendations
2	The commission shall report to the legislature and the governor with respect
3	to the findings of such studies, reviews, and analysis as it may undertake. The
4	commission shall submit its initial report prior to the 2004 Regular Session of the
5	Legislature, and annual reports prior to each regular session of the legislature, and
6	at such other times as it shall deem appropriate.
7	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
8	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
9	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
10	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
11	effective on the day following such approval.
