10	required subjects; Louisiana Educational Assessment Program; parish
11	or city school board comprehensive pupil progression plans; waivers

14	(i) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, for the
15	2020-2021 school year, the board shall examine the results from student
16	assessments and school-level test data but shall not use such assessments and
17	data for purposes of evaluating teacher performance or making placement
18	decisions for fourth and eighth grade students.

11	(2)(a) Fifty percent of each teacher and administrator evaluation conducted
12	pursuant to Paragraph (1) of this Subsection shall be based on evidence of growth in
13	student achievement as determined by the state board. Data derived from a value-
14	added assessment model, as determined by the state board, shall be a factor in
15	determining evidence of student growth for grade levels and subjects for which
16	value-added data is available and shall comprise thirty-five percent of the overall
17	evaluation. For grade levels and subjects for which value-added data is not available,
18	the state board shall establish measures of student growth. The model shall take into
19	account important student factors, including but not limited to special education,
20	economic disadvantage, attendance, and discipline. The state board shall develop and
21	adopt a policy to invalidate such student growth data for any teacher for any school
22	year in which there is a natural disaster or any other unexpected event that results in
23	the temporary closure of the school.
24	(b) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, for the
25	2020-2021 school year, value-added data shall not be used to evaluate teacher
26	performance or effectiveness.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

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vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
effective on the day following such approval.
