Abstract: Provides for eligibility and term limits for the elected trustees on the board of trustees for the Registrars of Voters Employees' Retirement System (ROVERS).

<u>Present law</u> provides for governance of ROVERS by a board of trustees composed of:

- (1) A member of the House Committee on Retirement appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives, or the member's designee.
- (2) The chairman of the Senate Committee on Retirement, ex officio, or his designee.
- (3) The secretary of state, ex officio, or his designee.
- (4) The state treasurer, ex officio, or his designee.
- (5) Six active and contributing members of the system elected by the members of the system.

<u>Present law</u> requires that the six active member trustees have at least 10 years of creditable service in the system. Proposed law reduces the required service to five years.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the term of the active member trustees is four years and limits the number of consecutive terms a member may serve. <u>Present law</u> provides that the limit is two consecutive terms. Proposed law increases that limit to three.

Effective July 1, 2021.
