Proposed law retains this provision.

Present law provides the acceptance not be executed except upon recommendation of the design professional hired by the public entity whose recommendation may not be later than 30 calendar days after completion or substantial compliance.

Proposed law retains this provision but requires that the acceptance as recommended by the design professional be made not later than 30 calendar days and requires that the public entity not take, use, or occupy the public work or use or occupy the specified area of the public work until substantial completion is filed. Provides that failure to comply is subject to a writ of mandamus.

Effective August 1, 2021.
