**Abstract:** Authorizes golf carts to cross La. Hwy. 26 at 4th St. within the town of Lake Arthur.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes golf carts to cross La. Hwy. 26 at 4th St. on marked or designated paths or crossings within the town limits of Lake Arthur between sunrise and sunset.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires a valid driver's license when operating a golf cart while crossing La. Hwy. 26 at 4th St. in the town of Lake Arthur.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows crossing signs to be posted by the Dept. of Transportation and Development at the request of the governing authority of the town of Lake Arthur.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> from certain requirements contained in <u>present law</u> and provides that golf carts must not be considered a vehicle for purposes of defining "equipment".
