<u>Present law</u> provides that an absentee by mail ballot must be returned to the registrar by the United States Postal Services, a commercial courier, or hand delivery.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and prohibits the use of a drop box for the purpose of returning a ballot to the registrar.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "drop box" to mean a monitored or unmonitored receptacle designated for the purpose of returning an absentee by mail ballot.
