Purpose of Bill: This bill authorizes the Lafayette City Marshal to use fees currently received by his office to increase his compensation by up to $50 \%$ of the salary paid by the City of Lafayette. The remainder of the fees and commissions are to be used to defray the expenses of the Marshal's Office.


## EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

This bill may increase local fund expenditures by up to $\$ 44,000$ annually.
An official with the Lafayette City Marshal's Office indicated that this bill may increase the expenditures of the Marshal's Office by up to $\$ 44,000$ annually ( $\$ 88,000$ annual salary from City of Lafayette $\times 50 \%$ ). However, the Marshal informed us that he may take a lesser compensation amount.

## REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
An official with the Lafayette City Marshal's Office indicated that this bill would not impact the revenue of the Marshal's Office as the Marshal's Office already collects the fees mentioned in the bill.
