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| HB 13 Engrossed  | 2021 Regular Session | Villio |
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Abstract: Provides for eligibility and term limits for the elected trustees on the board of trustees for the Registrars of Voters Employees' Retirement System (ROVERS).

Present law provides for governance of ROVERS by a board of trustees composed of:

- (1) A member of the House Committee on Retirement appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives, or the member's designee.
- (2) The chairman of the Senate Committee on Retirement, ex officio, or his designee.
- (3) The secretary of state, ex officio, or his designee.
- (4) The state treasurer, ex officio, or his designee.
- (5) Six active and contributing members of the system elected by the members of the system.

<u>Present law</u> requires that the six active member trustees have at least 10 years of creditable service in the system. <u>Proposed law</u> reduces the required service to five years.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the term of the active member trustees is four years and limits the number of consecutive terms a member may serve. <u>Present law</u> provides that the limit is two consecutive terms. <u>Proposed law</u> increases that limit to three.

Effective July 1, 2021.
