Amendments proposed by House Committee on Education to Original House Bill No. 322

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" and before "relative" delete "R.S. 17:3914(M)" and insert
3 "R.S. 17:3914(K)(2) and (3)(c)(i) and (M), to enact R.S. 17:3914(K)(1)(e), and to repeal R.S.
4 17:3914(M);"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, line 6, after "exceptions;" and before "to provide" insert "to authorize the sharing
7 of additional information;"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 8, after "program;" delete the remainder of the line and insert "to require the
10 collection of additional data by public school governing authorities; to provide relative to
11 the sharing of certain student information with the Board of Regents and the Office of
12 Student Financial Assistance; and to"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 4

14 On page 1, line 11, after "Section 1." delete the remainder of the line and insert "R.S.
15 17:3914(K)(2) and (3)(c)(i) and (M) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
16 17:3914(K)(1)(e) is hereby enacted to read as follows:"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 5

18 On page 1, between lines 14 and 15, insert the following:

19 "K.(1) Notwithstanding any provision of this Part to the contrary, the
20 governing authority of each public school, with the permission of a student's
21 parent or legal guardian, shall collect the following personally identifiable
22 information for each student enrolled in grades eight through twelve:

24 (e) Race and ethnicity data.

25 (2) The governing authority of a public school and the company that the state
26 has contracted with to develop the student unique identifier shall disclose the
27 information collected pursuant to Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, upon request,
28 only to:

29 (a) A Louisiana postsecondary education institution, to be used solely for the
30 purpose of processing applications for admission and for compliance with state and
31 federal reporting requirements.

32 (b) The Board of Regents and the Office of Student Financial Assistance, as
33 a program under its jurisdiction, to be used ~~solely~~ for the purpose of processing
34 applications made to the office for state and federal grants and for required grant
35 program reporting, for the purposes of providing reports to each public school
36 governing authority on the postsecondary education remediation needs, retention
37 rates, and graduation rates for each high school under its jurisdiction, and to evaluate
38 comparative postsecondary education performance outcomes based on student
39 transcript data in order to develop policies designed to improve student academic
40 achievement.

41 ~~(c) The Board of Regents, to be used only by board staff for the purposes of~~

7 (c) The form shall contain the following:

8 (i) A statement notifying the student's parent or legal guardian exactly what
9 items of student information will be collected and that disclosure of the student
10 information collected will be restricted to Louisiana postsecondary education
11 institutions to be used for the purposes of processing applications for admission and
12 for compliance with state and federal reporting requirements, to the Board of
13 Regents, and to the Office of Student Financial Assistance, as a program under such
14 board's jurisdiction, to be used solely for the purpose purposes of processing
15 applications for admission and for state and federal financial aid, and to the Board
16 of Regents to be used solely for the purposes of for required grant program reporting,
17 for providing reports to the school governing authority on the postsecondary
18 education remediation needs, retention rates, and graduation rates for each high
19 school under its jurisdiction, and for evaluating comparative postsecondary education
20 performance outcomes based on student transcript data in order to develop and
21 developing policies designed to improve student academic achievement.

24 On page 2, line 2, after "first name," and before "last" insert "middle name,"

25 AMENDMENT NO. 7

26 On page 2, line 3, after "address," and before "and date" insert "school site code, student
27 unique identifier,"

28 AMENDMENT NO. 8

29 On page 2, delete line 8 and insert the following:

30 "Section 2. R.S. 17:3914(M) is hereby repealed in its entirety.
31 Section 3.(A). Section 1 and this Section of this Act shall become effective upon
32 signature of this Act by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of
33 the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article
34 III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If this Act is vetoed by the governor and
35 subsequently approved by the legislature, Section 1 and this Section of this Act shall become
36 effective on the day following such approval.
37 (B) Section 2 of this Act shall become effective on December 31, 2022."
