4	physician or be employed by a clinic that has a medical director who is a licensed
5	physician. Additionally, any nurse practitioner, certified nurse midwife, or clinical
6	nurse specialist who practices in any specialty and transitions to independent practice
7	shall do so in collaboration with a physician who practices in that same specialty.
8	(2) Each nurse practitioner, certified nurse midwife, and clinical nurse
9	specialist shall submit written evidence to the board upon completion of the clinical
10	experience required in Paragraph (1) of this Subsection. Hours of clinical experience
11	gained in another state may count toward the clinical experience requirement
12	provided in Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, subject to approval by the board.
13	(3)(a) Any nurse practitioner, certified nurse midwife, or clinical nurse
14	specialist who did not complete four thousand clinical hours as a registered nurse

9	A. There is hereby created within the Louisiana Department of Health the
10	Independent Practice Advisory Panel, referred to hereafter in this Chapter as the
11	"advisory panel".
12	B. The advisory panel shall be composed of the following members:
13	(1) One physician appointed by the Louisiana State Medical Society.
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14	(2) One physician appointed by the Louisiana Medical Association.
15	(3) One physician appointed by the Louisiana Academy of Family
16	Physicians.
17	(4) Two advanced practice registered nurses appointed by the Louisiana
18	Association of Nurse Practitioners.
19	(5) One advanced practice registered nurse appointed by the Louisiana
20	Council of Administrators of Nursing Education.
21	(6) The executive director of the Louisiana State Board of Nursing, who
22	shall be a nonvoting member.
23	(7) The executive director of the Louisiana State Board of Medical
24	Examiners, who shall be a nonvoting member.

25	C. At its initial meeting, the advisory panel shall elect from its membership
26	a chairman and such other officers as it deems necessary and shall establish rules of
27	procedure and policies for the administration of its affairs.
28	D. The advisory panel shall meet at least semiannually.
29	E. Four members, at least two of whom are physicians and two of whom are
30	advanced practice registered nurses, shall constitute a quorum of the advisory panel.
31	F. The advisory panel shall have the following duties and responsibilities:
32	(1) Ensure quality of care post discipline action.
33	(2) Make recommendations on education items to reduce recurring
34	violations.
35	(3) Review complaints and concerns regarding advanced practice registered
36	nurses who practice independently and regarding physicians who collaborate with
37	advanced practice registered nurses.
38	(4) Develop advisory or practice opinions of any items brought before the
39	panel.
