2 seafood resources; and

3 WHEREAS, these same programs can also deliver conservation benefits for efforts  
4 to address concerns on climate, water supply, and wildlife habitat, repaying continued  
5 investment in conservation with wide-ranging benefits.

6 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
7 commend and support the important work being carried out by Louisiana's agricultural  
8 conservation partnerships for cooperative conservation and management in the state,  
9 including improved water quality, environmental health, and economic productivity, and  
10 convey this support to Louisiana's governor, lieutenant governor, and congressional  
11 delegation.
