SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Designates May 10, 2021, as Alzheimer's Awareness
Day at the state capitol

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To designate Monday, May 10, 2021, as Alzheimer's Awareness Day at the state capitol.

3 WHEREAS, there are currently more than 92,000 people suffering from Alzheimer's
4 or another type of dementia in Louisiana; and

5 WHEREAS, in the United States, Alzheimer's disease is the sixth leading cause of
6 death; and

7 WHEREAS, in Louisiana, it is estimated that more than 232,000 family caregivers
8 provide 318 million hours of unpaid care for family members with Alzheimer's; and

9 WHEREAS, studies predict that, by the year 2025, more than 110,000 persons in
10 Louisiana will be living with Alzheimer's.

11 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
12 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate Monday, May 10, 2021, as Alzheimer's
13 Awareness Day at the state capitol and does hereby encourage citizens of the great state of
14 Louisiana to raise awareness of this devastating disease.
