3 Peace in St. Charles Parish.

4 WHEREAS, Earl acquired the nickname "Pie" as a young boy, when many people
5 observed that being pale and freckled, his face looked like a little pie; and

6 WHEREAS, early in life, Earl dabbled in horse racing, winning six of seven races
7 as a jockey; and

8 WHEREAS, Earl began his career as a truck driver, working for Thompson-Hayward
9 Chemical Company and Decker; and

10 WHEREAS, upon his retirement from Decker, Earl tried his hand at politics as a
11 second career; and

12 WHEREAS, his first race was a strong yet unsuccessful showing as a candidate for
13 the school board, losing by only eight votes; and

14 WHEREAS, not deterred by his razor-thin loss, Earl successfully ran for the District
15 2 Justice of the Peace position in St. Charles Parish; and

17 Charles Parish School Board; and
