A RESOLUTION

To commend Brother Martin High School on winning the 2021 Louisiana High School Athletic Association boys' bowling championship.

WHEREAS, the Brother Martin High School Crusaders captured the school's fifth state championship in boys' bowling by defeating Central of Baton Rouge 21.5-5.5 in the final match of the LHSAA State Bowling Playoffs; and

WHEREAS, the Crusaders' dominating championship victory came on the heels of a thrilling semifinals upset over top-seeded Catholic High School of Baton Rouge; and

WHEREAS, the Crusaders were led by its three-time state champion, Drew Gardner, along with Andre Hoyeula and Ricky Carmona; and
