# 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 1, at the beginning of line 3, delete "18:435(A)(5) and (B)(1)(c), 1309(N) and
- 3 1366," and insert "18:435(A)(1)(c) and (5) and (B)(1)(c), 1309(N), 1366, and 1366.1,"
- 4 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 5 On page 1, line 10, after "reenacted and" delete "18:435(A)(5) and (B)(1)(c), 1309(N) and
- 6 1366" and insert "R.S. 18:435(A)(1)(c) and (5) and (B)(1)(c), 1309(N), 1366, and 1366.1"
- 7 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 8 On page 2, line 2, delete "A." and insert the following:
- 9 "A.(1) 10 \* \* \*
- 11 (c) A state central committee of a political party recognized pursuant to R.S.
- 12 <u>18:441, and having at least twenty-five percent of the registered voters in the state</u> 13 registered as being affiliated with the political party, is entitled to have one watcher
- 14 at every precinct on election day where a candidate affiliated with the political party
- is on the ballot. The chairman of the state central committee shall sign and file one list of watchers on a form provided by the secretary of state or on a form which
- contains the same information as required by the form provided by the secretary of
- 18 <u>state.</u>"
- 19 AMENDMENT NO. 4
- On page 5, line 25, after "state" change the period "." to a comma "," and insert "and may
- 21 include a hand marked secure paper ballot to be used as an option for day of voting."
- 22 AMENDMENT NO. 5
- On page 6, line 11, after "hardware" delete the comma "," and insert "which may include an
- 24 <u>optical scanner or tabulator,</u>"
- 25 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 6</u>
- On page 7, line 20, after "machines" insert "and tabulators"
- 27 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 7</u>
- On page 7, delete lines 23 and 24 in their entirety and insert the following
- "sealed until the termination of voting in the manner provided by R.S.
- 30 <u>18:571. However, access to physical ports on any voting machine may be used to</u>
- activate the voting machine for each voter's voting session, to repair the voting

1	machine in the manner provided by R.S. 18:553(C) or to tabulate and count absentee
2	by mail and early voting ballots in the manner provided by R.S. 18:1313 or 1313.1."

## 3 AMENDMENT NO. 8

- 4 On page 7, line 27, after "prohibited.' insert "If any voting equipment is capable of
- 5 <u>calculating fractional votes, such feature shall be disabled no later than thirty days prior to</u>
- 6 the commencement of early voting and remain disabled until all votes have been tabulated
- 7 and properly certified."

## 8 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 9</u>

9 On page 7, at the end of line 29, insert "Such record shall be used for risk limiting audits."

## 10 AMENDMENT NO. 10

- On page 8, delete line 8 in its entirety and insert "(9) Hand marked paper ballots shall have
- 12 counterfeit protection and shall not be printed at any polling location.'

# 13 AMENDMENT NO. 11

- On page 8, at the end of line 10, insert "Voting systems of a vendor owned in whole or in
- part by foreign persons or entities shall be prohibited.

# 16 AMENDMENT NO. 12

On page 8, between lines 10 and 11, insert the following:

- 18 "(12) The voting system shall meet all relevant requirements of the 19 Louisiana Election Code, Help America Vote Act, and any other relevant state and 20 federal laws.
- §1366.1. Voting systems; vendor prohibitions
- Vendors of any voting system or equipment and contractors providing election related services shall not engage in any of the following activities:
- 24 (1) Urging any elector to vote for or against any candidate or proposition on an election ballot.
- 26 (2) Expending resources in support for or against any candidate or proposition before Louisiana voters.
- 28 (3) Lobbying for or against any proposition or matter having the effect of law being considered by the Louisiana legislature or any local governing authority."
