Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Change date by which public school governing authorities are required to annually report to the state Dept. of Education <u>from Sept. 1st to Oct. 31st.</u>
- 2. Change date by which the state Dept. of Education is required to annually report to the legislature <u>from</u> Oct. 1st <u>to</u> Dec. 1st.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law provides for testing public school students for dyslexia.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires public school governing authorities to report to the state Dept. of Education relative to certain groups of students identified as having dyslexia, disaggregated by grade and type of education plan, by Oct. 31st annually. Requires the department to submit a cumulative report to the legislative education committees by Dec. 1st annually.
