2	To enact R.S. 47:302(BB)(114), 305.4, 321(P)(115), 321.1(I)(115), and 331(V)(115),
3	relative to tax exemptions; to provide an exemption from state sales and use tax for
4	utilities used by commercial farmers for on-farm storage; to authorize the secretary
5	of the Department of Revenue to promulgate rules; to provide for effectiveness; and
6	to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 47:302(BB)(114), 305.4, 321(P)(115), 321.1(I)(115), and
9	331(V)(115) are hereby enacted to read as follows:

23	A. Beginning October 1, 2021, the sales and use tax imposed by the state
24	of Louisiana shall not apply to the sale or use of utilities used by commercial

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1	farmers for on-farm storage.
2	B. For purposes of this Section:
3	(1)"Commercial farmer" shall have the same meaning as defined in R.S.
4	<u>47:301(30).</u>
5	(2) "On-farm storage" means facilities or containers located in Louisiana
6	that are separately metered for utilities and that contain raw agricultural
7	commodities, including but not limited to feed, seed, and fertilizer, to be utilized
8	in preparing, finishing, manufacturing, or producing crops or animals prior to
9	the first point of sale.
10	(3) "Utilities" means steam, water, electric power or energy, natural gas,
11	or energy sources as provided for in R.S. 47:305(D)(1)(b), (c), (d), (g), and (h).
12	C. The secretary of the Department of Revenue may promulgate rules
13	and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.
