| 9  | functions, duties  |
| 10 | A.(1) The Joint Medicaid Oversight Committee is hereby created and shall                   |
| 11 | consist of the following members of the House of Representatives and of the Senate:        |
| 12 | (a)(i) Six members of the House of Representatives appointed by the speaker                |
| 13 | of the House of Representatives in a manner to reflect the makeup of the membership        |
| 14 | of the House of Representatives, including party affiliation, race, sex, and geography,    |
| 15 | to the extent practicable. Three of the members appointed by the speaker shall be          |
| 16 | members of the House Committee on Appropriations, and three of the members                 |
| 17 | appointed by the speaker shall be members of the House Committee on Health and             |
| 18 | Welfare.   |
| 19 | (ii) However, if a member of the House of Representatives appointed                        |
| 20 | pursuant to Subitem (i) of this Item is unable to attend a meeting of the special joint    |
| 21 | committee, the member may request the speaker to designate, and the speaker may            |
| 22 | so designate, another member of the House of Representatives to serve as his proxy         |
