CURRICULA: Provides relative to content standards for social studies in public schools

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Delete <u>proposed law</u> relative to specific content of required instruction on American history and civics in public schools in grades K-12.
- 2. Require the State Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) to incorporate certain topics into social studies content standards.
- 3. Require BESE to publish notices of hearings regarding the development of social studies standards in the official journal of every parish.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) to incorporate standards related to the following topics into the state content standards for social studies:

- (1) The U.S. Constitution.
- (2) The Bill of Rights.
- (3) Civics.
- (4) The Holocaust.
- (5) African American history.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires BESE to publish a notice of any hearing held regarding the development of social studies standards pursuant to <u>proposed law</u> in the official journal of each parish in the state.
