Proposed law allows the state central committee of each recognized political party having at least 25% of registered voters (currently the Republican Party and the Democratic Party) may have one watcher in every precinct as well as super watchers in each parish where that party is represented on the ballot in primary and general elections and the number of super watchers is based on the number of registered voters in each parish. Proposed law allows the state central committee of each recognized political party having at least 25% of registered voters may designate early voting watchers and alternative watchers at each early voting location. Proposed law effective 1/01/2022.


