<u>Existing law</u> establishes the Dual Enrollment Framework Task Force to make recommendations for a statewide dual enrollment framework to provide universal access to dual enrollment courses. Requires local public school boards to develop agreements with colleges and universities for articulation and transfer of credit.

<u>Prior law</u> provided for task force termination on June 30, 2021. <u>New law</u> repeals <u>prior law</u>. Further provides that the task force is responsible for implementing the dual enrollment framework.

<u>Prior law</u> required the Bd. of Regents to submit a written report of task force findings and recommendations to the legislative committees on education by Oct. 1, 2020. <u>New law</u> requires annual submission of such a report.

<u>New law</u> adds one member to the task force, a secondary school teacher who teaches a dual enrollment course.

Effective August 1, 2021.
