BY SENATORS MCMATH, HENRY, MILLIGAN, MORRIS AND TALBOT

HEALTH CARE. Requires acceptance of a COVID-19 antibody test result in satisfaction of any requirement for proof of vaccine. (8/1/22)

1 AN ACT
2 To enact R.S. 40:31.2, relative to acceptance of a COVID-19 antibody test result in
3 satisfaction of any requirement for proof of vaccine; to provide for the COVID-19
4 antibody test to be approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration;
5 and to provide for related matters.
6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7 Section 1. R.S. 40:31.2 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8 **§31.2. COVID-19 antibody test; required substitution**
9 **Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, proof that an**
10 **individual has tested positive for the COVID-19 antibody, through a test**
11 **approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration, shall be accepted**
12 **as satisfaction of any state entity, local or municipal body, or city or parish**
13 **school board requirement for proof of a COVID-19 vaccine for entry,**
14 **employment, attendance, admittance, or as otherwise adopted or implemented**
15 **in a manner that restricts access or opportunity.**
