Abstract: Establishes an inference that the registered owner of a vehicle has disposed of litter when there is photographic evidence of the license plate of the vehicle from which the litter was disposed.

<u>Present law</u> provides that when litter is disposed of from a motor vehicle, boat, or conveyance, there shall be an inference that the driver disposed of the litter. Further provides that if the litter was possessed by a specific person immediately before the act of disposing, there is an inference that the possessor committed the act of disposing.

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes an inference that the registered owner of a vehicle has disposed of litter when there is photographic evidence of the license plate of the vehicle from which the litter was disposed.
