Abstract: Provides for stays in workers' compensation cases.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that upon an uncontested motion to stay or a joint motion to stay of the parties, the workers' compensation judge shall order a stay of the proceeding on a claim and the stay shall remain in effect as long as both parties agree.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that when a motion to stay is granted, a telephone status conference shall be set at intervals at the direction of the workers' compensation judge. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides that the telephone status conference must occur at least every six months.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the abandonment provision pursuant to LAC 40:1.5705(A), shall not apply to a matter that is subject to a stay order pursuant to <u>proposed law</u> during the pendency of the stay.
