Boudreaux

<u>Present law</u> provides for the qualifications required for a pharmacist currently licensed in another jurisdiction to apply for a license as a pharmacist by reciprocity in Louisiana.

Proposed law retains present law.

SB 97 Original

<u>Present law</u> provides that no applicant shall be eligible for licensure by reciprocity unless the state or jurisdiction in which the applicant was initially licensed as a pharmacist also grants reciprocity to a pharmacist duly licensed by examination in this state, under comparable circumstances and conditions.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains the requirement for dual reciprocity but removes the specific requirement that there be comparable circumstances and conditions.

Effective August 1, 2022.
