Abstract: Provides relative to exceptions to the public records law for certain work products by district attorneys, assistant district attorneys, district attorney investigators, or district attorney victims assistance coordinators.

Present law provides for exceptions to the public records law.

Proposed law adds an exception for any writings, records, or other accounts that reflect the mental impressions, conclusions, opinions, or theories of any district attorney, assistant district attorney, district attorney investigator, or district attorney victims assistance coordinator relative to any actual or potential criminal case, criminal appeal, post conviction litigation pursuant to present law (C.Cr.P.), or any federal habeas corpus litigation.

Proposed law shall not be construed to limit the applicability of any other present law exception, exemption, or limitation.
