Abstract: Increases the penalties for gross littering involving tires and failure to obtain a generator identification number.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the penalty for failure to obtain a generator identification number is a fine of not less than \$300 but not more than \$500, or imprisonment for six months, or both.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the monetary fine <u>from</u> not less than \$300 but not more than \$500 to \$5,000. Retains the <u>present law</u> penalty relative to imprisonment.

<u>Present law</u> establishes the penalties for gross littering upon first, second, and third or subsequent conviction.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> penalties for gross littering and adds the following penalties specific to gross littering involving tires:

- (1) First conviction fined \$1,800 and is responsible for the cost of removal, transportation, and processing of the tires.
- (2) Second conviction fined not less than \$4,000 and not more than \$10,000 and is responsible for the cost of removal, transportation, and processing of the tires.
- (3) Third or subsequent conviction fined not less than \$6,000 and not more than \$20,000 and is responsible for the cost of removal, transportation, and processing of the tires.
