Abstract: Removes provisions prohibiting retail dealers from permitting individuals under the age of 18 from visiting licensed premises that serve alcohol.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 26:90) prohibits certain acts from occurring on a licensed premises of individuals who hold a retail dealer's permit or are permitted to sell alcoholic beverages at retail.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits individuals from intentionally enticing, aiding, or permitting individuals under the age of 18 from visiting or loitering in any place where alcoholic beverages or beer are the principal commodities.

<u>Present law</u> provides an exception for the presence of individuals under the age of 18 who are at functions sponsored by religious organizations, charitable organizations, or fraternal beneficiary societies where no alcoholic beverages are sold or accessible during the presence of the individual.

Proposed law removes present law.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 26:286) prohibits certain acts from occurring on a licensed premises of individuals who hold a permit for dealers in beverages of low alcoholic content.

<u>Present law</u> provides an exception for the presence of individuals under the age of 18 who are at functions sponsored by religious organizations, charitable organizations, or fraternal beneficiary societies where no alcoholic beverages are sold or accessible during the presence of the individual.

Proposed law removes present law.
