Abstract: Provides for new assistant district attorney positions for various judicial districts in the state.

Present law provides for the number of assistant district attorneys for the various judicial districts.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the number of assistant district attorneys in particular judicial districts as follows:

- (1) 1st JDC <u>from</u> 27 <u>to</u> 35.
- (2) 5th JDC from 6 to 7.
- (3) 7th JDC <u>from</u> 5 <u>to</u> 6.
- (4) 14th JDC from 23 to 25.
- (5) 15th JDC from 19 to 28.
- (6) 16th JDC from 21 to 23.
- (7) 18th JDC from 10 to 12.
- (8) 19th JDC from 48 to 53.
- (9) 21st JDC from 18 to 19.
- (10) 24th JDC from 52 to 54.
- (11) 29th JDC from 9 to 10.
- (12) 32nd JDC from 19 to 20.
- (13) 36th JDC <u>from</u> 4 <u>to</u> 5.
- (14) 37th JDC <u>from</u> 2 <u>to</u> 3.

Effective on August 1, 2022, provided that funding for the additional 37 assistant district attorney positions is appropriated and payable out of the state general fund in the general appropriations bill for the state.
