2	To amend and reenact R.S. 4:214(G) and (L), relative to horse racing; to provide for pari-

6	Section 1. R.S. 4:214(G) and (L) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as

12	G. In no case may An offtrack wagering facilities facility shall not accept
13	wagers on races run at any track without a contract with the licensee operating the
14	host track. This contract shall include all terms and conditions for use of races run
15	at the host track by the offtrack wagering facility, including compensation of the host
16	track for such use. This contract shall be filed with the commission. No host track
17	may deny the use of its races by any other offtrack wagering facility in Louisiana

Cortez

<u>Present law</u>, regarding horse racing, provides that in no case may offtrack wagering facilities (OTBs) accept wagers on races run at any track without a contract with the licensee operating the host track. Provides that the contract shall include all terms and conditions for use of races run at the host track by the OTB, including compensation of the host track for such use. Requires the contract to be filed with the commission. Prohibits a host track from denying the use of its races by any other OTB in Louisiana under the same terms and conditions.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits historical horse racing from being conducted via a machine or website or mobile application beyond the property of the pari-mutuel facility or OTB. Requires the commission to promulgate rules relative to the enforcement of <u>present law</u>.

Proposed law retains present law but makes technical changes.

Effective August 1, 2022.
