Talbot

<u>Present law</u> provides that the producer may receive reimbursement from the insured for expenses incurred by the producer directly related to the insurance coverage for the insured. The producer may charge a reasonable agency fee related to the services provided by the producer. Any reimbursement or agency fee shall be itemized separately on an invoice statement. A single invoice may be used to make known all charges. Each such charge must be prominently disclosed and itemized separately on the invoice.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> from the reimbursement or agency fee, but excepts any reimbursement or agency fee charged by the producer of a surety bond issued in accordance with the public works law.

Effective July 1, 2022.
