SENATE BILL NO. 279

BY SENATOR FRED MILLS

PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS. Names the public building located in Rockefeller Wildlife Refuge the "J. Burton Angelle Building". (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 49:149.35, relative to names of state buildings; to name the J. Burton Angelle
3 Building; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 49:149.35 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 **§149.35. J. Burton Angelle Building**

7 **The state building situated in the community of Grand Chenier, having**
8 **the municipal address of 5476 Grand Chenier Highway, and generally known**
9 **as Rockefeller Wildlife Refuge main office building, is hereby named and shall**
10 **hereafter be known as the J. Burton Angelle Building.**

11 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
12 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
13 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
14 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
15 effective on the day following such approval.
