BAIL: Provides relative to bail hearings for subsequent arrests involving the possession of a firearm

1	AN ACT
2	To enact Code of Criminal Procedure Article 313.2, relative to bail; to provide relative to
3	certain persons who are subsequently arrested; to require a hearing for such persons
4	prior to setting bail; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. Code of Criminal Procedure Article 313.2 is hereby enacted to read as
7	follows:
8	Art. 313.2. Subsequent arrest for an offense involving a firearm; bail hearings
9	Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any person who is
10	released on a bail undertaking, who is on supervised probation, who is on supervised
11	parole, or who is on supervised release as provided for in Chapter 3-E of Title 15 of
12	the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 and subsequently arrested for any offense
13	involving the possession of a firearm, shall appear before a judge for a hearing to set
14	bail.

Abstract: Requires any person who is released on a bail undertaking, on supervised probation, on supervised parole, or on supervised release and subsequently arrested for an offense involving the possession of a firearm to appear before a judge for a bail hearing.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires any person who is released on a bail undertaking, on supervised probation, on supervised parole, or on supervised release as provided for in <u>present law</u> and subsequently arrested for any offense involving the possession of a firearm, to appear before a judge for a hearing to set bail.
